Objectives

2. IMI Patient engagement strategy

- Involvement in IMI projects
- IMI governance
 - Involvement in assessment of Short Proposals where appropriate
 - Recommendation to involve in consortia where impact on patient expected
 - Central body acting as advisor, e.g. IMI Patient advisory committee
 - Patient representative on scientific committee to be selected from the central body
- Lay summary of outcomes of project results
- Case study collection
- Patient education towards participating in consortia
